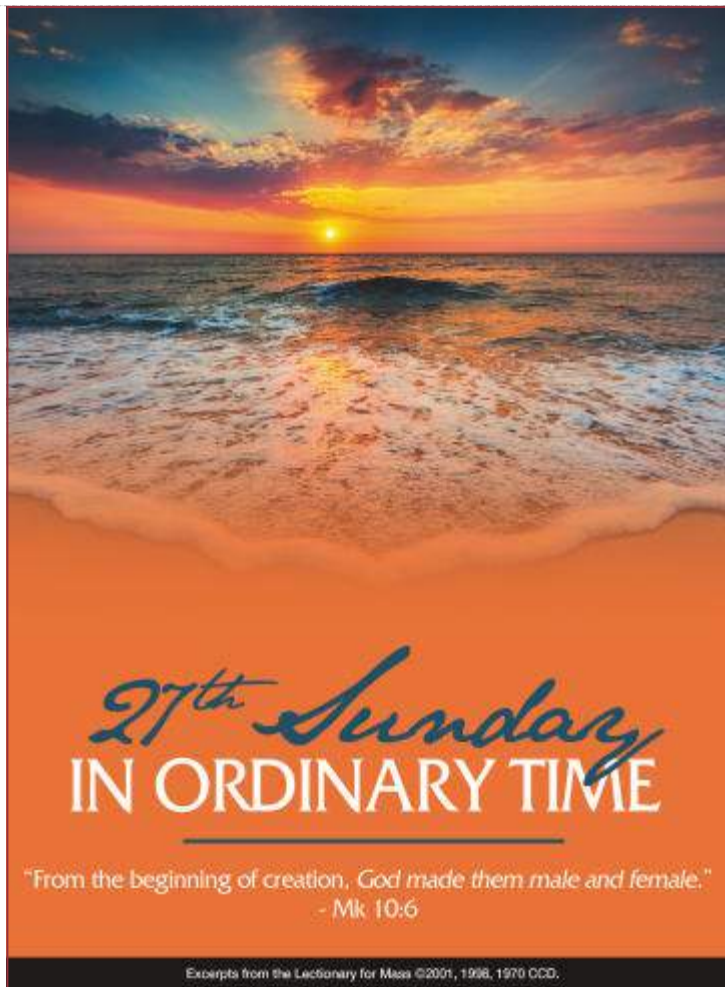

First is the prayer to Michael the Archangel, the heavenly being traditionally associated especially with combating the devil.



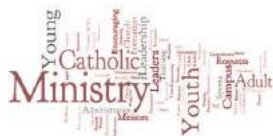
