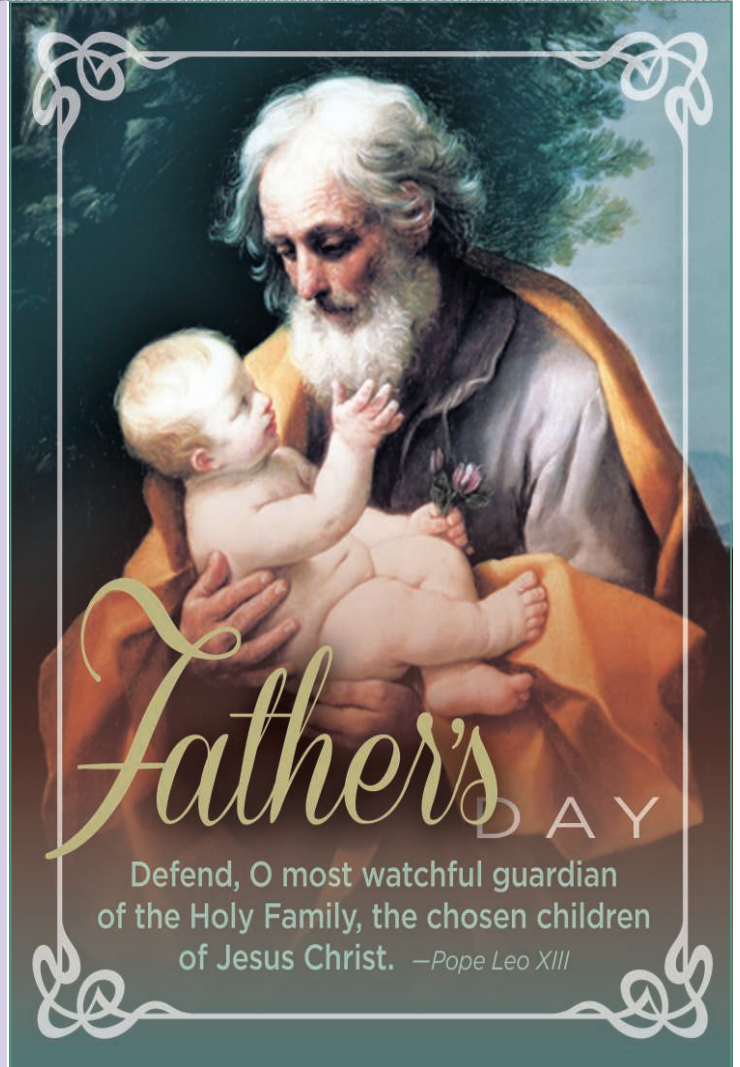

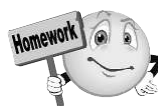

From Fr. Rob



“As we continue our journey through St. Paul’s Letter to the Galatians, keep in mind the overall theme of justification in Christ (how Jesus makes us right with God). Now as we read the latter chapters, also consider Paul’s thoughts on Christ in relation to “the Law,” which is the Law of Moses, or what Christians might call “the Old Testament Law.” This is not the Ten Commandments, which remain law for us to this day, but the old ritual laws of Judaism (ie, Temple sacrifices, diet laws, etc). Why does Paul see Jesus as the fulfillment of the old ritual laws, and how does the Cross and Resurrection of Christ grant us new freedom?”

Also, in light of the overall theme of this weekend’s readings relating to the Cross of Christ, especially the words of the prophet Zechariah in our first reading, “...and they shall look on him whom they have pierced,” consider designated some space in your home as sacred space with a crucifix as its center. Begin the habit of praying in front of that crucifix, even if it’s just a moment of silent adoration. Ask for the grace daily to take up your own cross and follow Christ as His faithful disciple. Let this sacred space in your home become a spiritual center of gravity that sanctifies your home and your home life. Google the term “Catholic home altars” to see what others have done, both simple and elaborate, to sanctify their homes and create a space in which to gaze upon the pierced One.

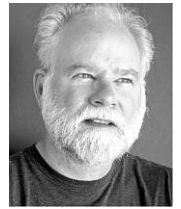
